Subject: Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement for
Maintenance and Operation of Traffic Control Signals
West Mill Road and North 64th Street and
West Oklahoma Avenue and South 76th Street

Dear Honorable Members:

The Jurisdictional Transfer for Maintenance and Operation of traffic control signals at the subject intersections with Milwaukee County will ensure more efficient operation and traffic flow. Milwaukee County is reconstructing South 76th Street at West Oklahoma Avenue beginning in April 2007 and will incorporate the operation of the traffic control signal into two signal systems during and after paving work is completed. The City of Milwaukee will transfer maintenance and operation of the traffic control signal at West Oklahoma Avenue and South 76th Street to Milwaukee County and Milwaukee County will transfer maintenance and operation of the traffic control signal at West Mill Road and North 64th Street to the City of Milwaukee.

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes Commissioner of Public Works and Comptroller to enter into an agreement with the Milwaukee County for the Jurisdictional Transfer for the operation and maintenance of traffic control signals at the subject intersections in the 2nd, 9th, and 11th Aldermanic Districts.
