The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 01/08/21 at 2:48am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4925 S. Howell Avenue for a trouble with subject complaint. Upon police arrival the subject left.

Investigation revealed that two subject ordered food at the location, ate it, and left without paying for it.
