REASON FOR REQUEST:

Carnita Carter, a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of her employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling eastbound on West Lisbon Avenue. When Ms. Carter stopped her vehicle for the traffic signal at the intersection of West Lisbon Avenue and North 76th Street, the uninsured motorist, Ms. Jessica Hanson, who was traveling southbound on North 76th Street, lost control of her vehicle, striking the front/driver's side of the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Ms. Carter sustained injuries to her neck, back, and left shoulder. The treating orthopedic surgeon indicated that the left shoulder injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$35,571.50.
