This damage claim is in reference to a vehicle that was damaged by the City of Milwaukee Tow Lot et al based upon an illegal tow that was conducted without permission and lack of knowledge from the vehicle owner or the owner of the private property. The vehicle was directed to be towed to the complainant on or about August 9, 2008 by CH1 Tow Company by direction of the City of Milwaukee Tow Lot because of extensive damage to the oil pan, rendering the vehicle undriveable. The complainant went on to notice extensive damage to the trunk lock, driver's door lock, hood latch release, dent in driver's side door, rear view mirror, and unremovable paint on the roof of the car. Complainant was initially given complaint form by tow lot staff to complete for reimbursement for damages after speaking with a Mr. Tom Sanders, Parking Enforcement Manager, who assured complainant would be promptly reimbursed for damages. The complainant is yet to hear from the complaint to this date. In addition the form is not the proper form to be completed for damages. The complainant feel that he has been given the run and around and haphazardly misdirected in trying to bring this matter to a solution. Fortunately the complainant was advised properly by counsel. This claim for damage is an attempt to resolve this issue administratively. Thank you for your time...
