Troy Johnson, a City of Milwaukee police detective, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee police squad car that was traveling southbound on North 35th Street with its emergency lights and siren activated. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West Chambers Street and North 35th Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding eastbound on West Chambers Street, failed to yield the right-of-way and collided with the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Detective Johnson sustained injuries to his head, neck, back, and bilateral knees. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$20,776.60
