To whom it may concern,

This letter will confirm my discussion with Rodney Kenel on 12/18/2025 regarding the replacement of his asbestos slate roof with a concrete slate tile vs the Brava composite roof tile.

As we discussed, the current asbestos slate roof system weighs about 250-470 lbs per square and a concrete slate roof system weighs about 800-1,000lbs per square. A reasonable high quality replacement would be the Brava composite roofing system which also weighs about 250-430lbs per square.

#### C. Loss Settlement.

1. For Coverage A - Dwelling, "we" will pay the cost to repair or replace the dwelling without deduction for depreciation, but not more than the least of the following amounts:

a. The replacement cost of that part of the dwelling damaged by fire or explosion, if the dwelling had been rebuilt at a new premises, the cost described in this item would be limited to the cost which would have been incurred if the dwelling had been rebuilt at the original premises;
