# ELECTION OF PRESIDENT & VICE PRESIDENT (ANNUAL MEETING)

### **SECRETARY**

- 1. Assume Chair
- 2. Announce Election

"Annual meeting of the Board of City Service Commissioners under the provisions of Section 63.18 of the Wisconsin Statutes, which says, 'The Commission shall, at a meeting in July of each year, elect one member to act as President and one member to act as Vice President, each for a term of one year and until a successor is duly elected.""

3. Call for and receive Nominations for Office of President

"Nominations are now in order for the Office of President" Note: Nominations do not require a second.

- 4. Ask for further nominations three times
  - 1. "Are there any further nominations"
  - 2. "Are there any further nominations"
  - 3. "Are there any further nominations"

(Unless a motion to close nominations is made, seconded & carried by a 2/3 vote)

- 5. Declare Nominations Closed
- 6. Ask Nominee(s) if Willing to Serve

#### COMMISSION VOTES

Since bylaws do not prescribe a voting procedure, voting may be viva voce, by roll call, etc. Traditionally, we have done it by roll, called by the Assistant Secretary.

Note: If only one nominee is named for an office, you may declare that person elected by 'general consent' or 'acclamation.'

- 7. Announce Election Results
- 8. Repeat #1 #7 for Office of Vice President
- 9. Vacate Chair
