Mural Cloth is a synthetic, ready to paint, bright white polymer substrate designed for maximum durability and outdoor stability. It has a premium polymer based primed coating encapsulating the polymer fibers that is designed to provide a non-reflective surface offering excellent abrasion resistance, optimal color vibrancy and surface tooth. Mural Cloth is a fine art surface that can be painted with any medium including acrylics, house paints, aerosols, and other materials suitable for mural painting. It can be installed with acrylic adhesive, strainers, or spring systems with edge reinforcement. Mural Cloth comes in two ultrawide sizes, allowing artists the ability to create seamless murals. Mural Cloth is fire rated per ASTM E84 and NFPA 701 FR, and is compatible with MuralColors Preservation System.

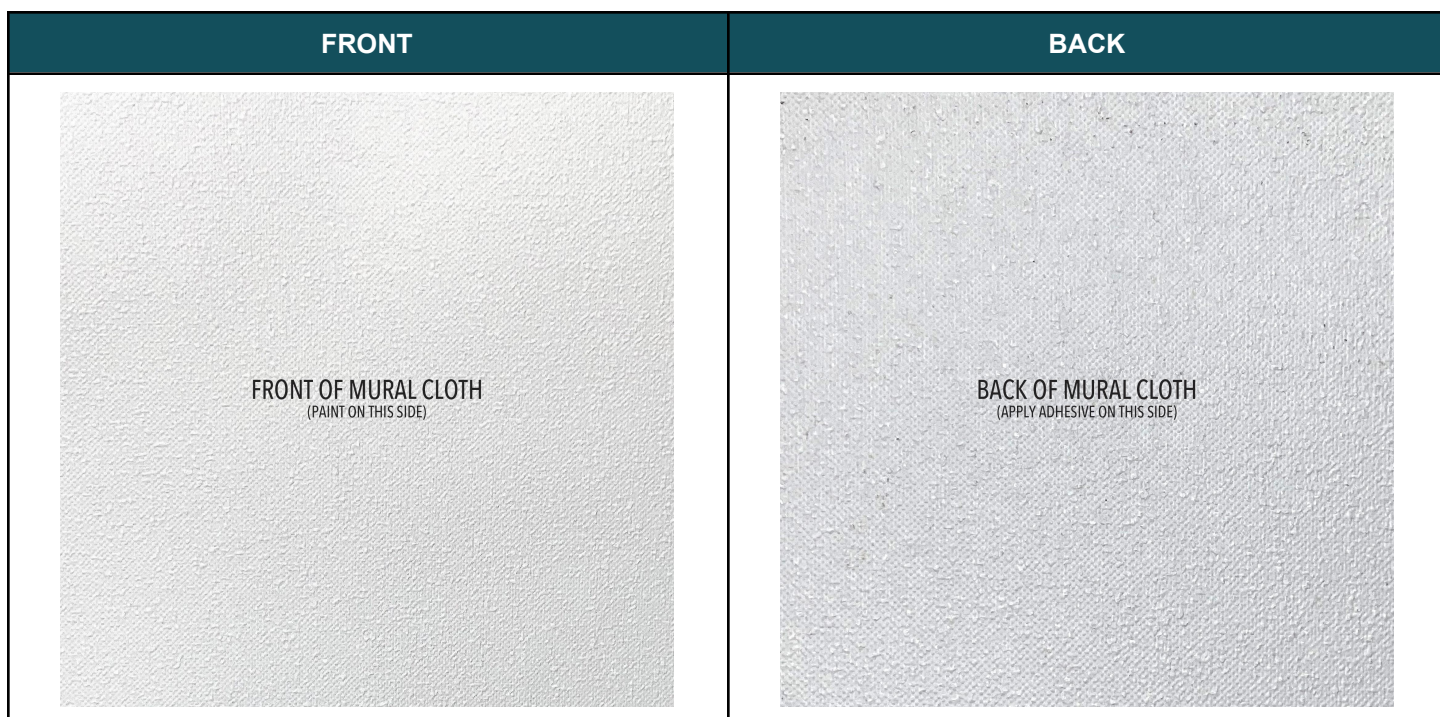

FAQS

Do I have to prime Mural Cloth before painting it?

No, Mural Cloth comes fully primed for outdoors or indoors and is ready to paint.

Can I install Mural Cloth in situ before painting my mural?

Yes, you can install Mural Cloth and then paint over it on the wall, or temporarily install it in your studio and move it to its final location at a later date.

Is Mural Cloth removable?

Yes, Mural Cloth is permanent and completely removable if adhered with an acrylic gel adhesive. A careful sturdy tug to the edge of the Mural Cloth while also using a medium pressure stream of water from a hose or pressure washer will produce a clean removal. Mural Cloth is especially useful in situations where murals have to be removable and leave no trace on the building surface.

Can I Install Mural Cloth Outdoors?

Yes! Mural Cloth was designed to be painted on and installed outdoors! Mural Cloth is able to withstand outdoor conditions (rain, heat, humidity, snow) when properly installed. Mural Cloth should be treated like any fine art painted mural surface. Care should be taken to properly seal the edges of Mural Cloth with acrylic gel adhesive when installed. A typical water abatement strategy should be taken to keep water seepage from affecting the installed artwork.

Can I use Mural Cloth indoors?

Mural Cloth can be used as a wallcovering, or as a stretched fine art canvas. It can be installed directly on a wall, or on stretcher bars or frames, and even ceilings. Mural Cloth should not be installed on walking surfaces. Mural Cloth is suitable for restaurants, hotels, schools, museums, corporate lobbies, high traffic areas, decorative ceilings and compound surfaces, in challenging environments where artists have limited access, and over surfaces that require removability.

Can I coat Mural Cloth after painting my mural?

Yes, we recommend applying ColorShield and OverCoat to preserve the painted surface and protect your mural from tagging or buffing.

Can I cut Mural Cloth down to smaller sizes?

Yes, Mural Cloth can be cut down with a sharp knife or scissors without fraying. If installing with gel adhesive, make sure to apply adhesive on the edges of Mural Cloth to seal the edges.

What other ways can Mural Cloth be installed?

Mural Cloth can be installed with acrylic gel adhesive, stretched on strainers, and mechanically installed using most signage techniques. Mechanical installations should take the tensile strength of Mural Cloth into consideration. If installing Mural Cloth under high tension, reinforce the edges.

What mediums can I use to paint on Mural Cloth?

Mural Cloth can be painted on with any fine art material, including acrylics, spray paint, and mixed media. Artists can use fine art oils, house paints, and any other materials that would be used on a fine art surface. Not all media are suitable for outdoor environments. If you have questions about suitable outdoor materials, feel free to consult us.

Does Mural Cloth require any maintenance?

Mural Cloth can be washed and treated like a traditionally painted mural. Murals on Mural Cloth should not be pressure washed with high force. If adhered edges peel, they can be reattached with additional acrylic gel adhesive. Tagged murals can be repaired like normal painted surfaces.

Can I install Mural Cloth in multiple panels?

Yes, Mural Cloth can be installed in panels. Seams can be painted over with acrylic paint and they should be well sealed with acrylic gel adhesive.

Can I install Mural Cloth over brick walls?

Yes, and be sure to use extra gel. If the wall is extremely textured, with sharp and irregular variances, consider using a mechanical installation instead of acrylic adhesive.

Is Mural Cloth fire rated?

Yes per test NFPA 701 FR and ASTM E84

Can I paint on both sides of Mural Cloth?

Yes! The back of Mural Cloth has more texture in order to be more receptive to acrylic gel adhesive. Some artists may prefer to paint on the coarse side.

Can I order various sizes of Mural Cloth?

Yes, simply select the yard length and add it to your cart. You can select various yard lengths or entire rolls. Due to the customization of each order, Mural Cloth is non refundable.

How long does it take to receive Mural Cloth?

Due to the size of Mural Cloth, it might take up to 3 weeks for delivery depending on your location. If you need Mural Cloth sooner, please contact us at hello@muralcolors.com.

How does Mural Cloth arrive?

Mural Cloth arrives carefully folded. Any creases or wrinkles formed during shipping can be worked out by wetting the surface with water and allowing it to dry once on a studio wall, or by placing Mural Cloth in the sun. Creases relax over time and should not cause concern.

Do you have smaller widths of Mural Cloth?

Mural Cloth is available in 126 and 196 inch wide rolls.
