1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):
This is an annual grant renewal for funds from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) that support Milwaukee Health Departments Sexual and Reproductive Health Program (SRH). These funds support clinic services to clients accessing the walk-in clinic at the Keenan Health Center. Funds are designated for a Public Health Nurse and medical assistant, as well a medical consultant and clinical supplies necessary to provide reproductive health care. The SRH clinic serves approximately 6,500 clients per year for serves related to reproductive health care including STI testing, diagnosis, and treatment, birth control options including emergency contraception and pregnancy tests as well as education and prevention counseling.
2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:
Milwaukee continues to be a city with high rates of STI's which disproportionately affect minority patients. Addressing the STI rates in the City of Milwaukee is a priority for improving the overall health of the community. This also affords the opportunity to provide additional services at our South Side Health Center and in the community to help reduce barriers to care.
3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):
These funds support clinical services at the Keenan Health Center, which provides free, confidential walk-in services to the Milwaukee Community.
