
Dear Ms. Horn:


We have received your claim in the amount of \$2,001.44, relating to damage caused to your vehicle on February 4, 2011 when a City vehicle allegedly struck it at 1647 West Leroy Avenue.

Our investigation reveals that the Fleet Accident Report completed as a result of this alleged incident noted the damage is not consistent with damage caused by a garbage truck. Our office spoke with the Support Services investigator assigned to this incident. He noted, your vehicle also had red paint on it in addition to the noted yellow paint. He said the City vehicles do not have any red on them and other large trucks use this alley. Since there is no evidence to support your belief a City truck caused your loss, the City cannot accept liability and we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
