This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$2,059.53, relating to damages sustained to your vehicle allegedly by a City snowplow on December 19, 2000 at 2251 South Mound Street.

The Fleet Accident Report completed as a result of this alleged incident notes that the investigator sent by the fleet division indicates the damage on your vehicle is not consistent plow damage. Additionally, your vehicle did not have any yellow or orange paint transfer. Since there is no evidence to support your belief that a City vehicle caused the damage, the City cannot accept liability. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.
