There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with  
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 10/30/17 the applicant was cited by West Allis Police for Operating While Intoxicated. On 01/03/18 the applicant was convicted and his license was revoked for 6 months.  
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2. On 03/26/23 at 2:45a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Fight at 551 W. Historic Mitchell St. On arrival officers dispersed the crowd that was gathered outside the establishment. Upon entrance officers located an intoxicated subject bleeding from the mouth, however, refused medical attention. The officers interviewed the manager, who stated a fight initiated between two highly intoxicated customers. The manager further stated there was security on scene, however, left due to feeling overwhelmed and not feeling they could contain the crowd themselves.
3. On 12/14/23 at 8:41p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Threat at 551 W. Historic Mitchell St. Investigation revealed the business has had trouble with a subject in the past who is known to order and eat food then leave without paying. On this date after the subject was seated and placed their order, the wait staff requested payment prior to placing the order. The subject became angry and started yelling and throwing things at employees. The agent arrived on scene and was cooperative allowing officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

4. On 12/19/23 at 1:55a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a complaint a business was serving alcohol after-hours at 551 W. Historic Mitchell St. On arrival officers' subjects seated at the bar with food and beers. The employee was cooperative and provided all license information to the officers.

5. On 12/20/23 at 2:00a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 551 W. Historic Mitchell St. On arrival officers observed 11 patrons inside after 2:00a.m., and alcohol was still being served. All employees on scene denied knowledge they were supposed to be closed by 2:00a.m. The owner was contacted via telephone and stated they didn't know why the business was still open.

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6. On 01/24/24 at 3:00p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 551 W. Historic Mitchell St. Assisting in this assignment were Agents from Wisconsin Department of Revenue Alcohol and Tobacco. The officers noted none of the employees on site held an Operator License. The agent arrived shortly after and was advised of the violation. There were no invoices for liquor on site and 90 bottles were seized by the Revenue Agent.

This report is written by PO Matthew DIENER, assigned to District 2, day shift, squad 2166. On Wednesday, January 24, 2024, at approximately 3:00pm, squad 2166 (DIENER, VODICKA), squad 2164 (CONTRERAS), along with Alcohol and Tobacco agents from the WI Dept of Revenue conducted a tavern inspection at Taqueria El Toro, located at 551 W Historic Mitchell St.

Upon arrival, PO CONTRERAS translated English/Spanish during the inspection, and asked the server, Diana L GALLARDO (w/f, 6-9-02) if the licensee, Toribio PEREZ-MARTINEZ (owner) was on site. GALLARDO said he was not. CONTRERAS then asked if she, or anyone else on site had a bartender's license, which GALLARDO stated that nor she, or anyone else on site had a bartender's license. She then stated that PEREZ-MARTINEZ will be there shortly. PEREZ-MARTINEZ subsequently arrived on premise and was briefed by Revenue agents regarding the inspection.

During the inspection, Agent SCHNEURING observed that PEREZ-MARTINEZ does not have any invoices from any liquor distributors, and had 90 bottles of liquor that were seized and or destroyed by the Dept of Revenue. We advised PEREZ-MARTINEZ that he must be on premise or have an employee on site with a bartender's license in order to serve beer/liquor. We advised PEREZ-MARTINEZ that he will be cited for 90-8, Responsible Person on Premise.

### LICENSED PREMISE REPORT

This report is written by PO Dellian MENDEZ-SANTIAGO (PS#028797) assigned to District Two, Late Power shift, in full duty uniform, operating marked MPD Squad 205, and equipped with my department issued body worn camera, which captured this incident.

On Saturday, July 27, 2024, Officers and Police Aides performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. There was one team that was part of this initiative. Our team consisted of an MPD Police Aide, a Police Officer, both which were acting in a plainclothes capacity with a uniformed Police Officer monitoring them from a short distance away. The Police Aide for our team was under the age of 21. This was verified by their respective Wisconsin driver's license. Police Aide Victoria A PAGAN (PS#037189) and Police Officer Maritza REYES (PS#036320) were in plainclothes while I, along with Police Officer Jesus RODRIGUEZ JR(PS#029217), Police Officer Justin MERRITT (PS#031959), and Sergeant Jonathan MEJIA-RIVERA were all in full uniform.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed establishments, the Police Aide and Police Officer were given instructions. Our plainclothes member of this initiative was advised they were not to produce any identification to any of the establishment. If they were asked to produce identifications, they would say they forgot it or didn't have one to attempt to gain entry. It was explained that the Police Aide would order one alcoholic beverage, and the plainclothes Officer would order a soda or water. The plainclothes members would provide a detailed description to the uniformed Officers if they were successful in being served an alcoholic beverage. Uniformed Officers would then return to the establishment to confirm the identity of the person who sold the alcoholic beverage to the Police Aide. The uniformed Officers will notify the person that they served a department member who was acting in a plain clothes capacity and failed our investigation. The uniformed officer would then inform them that they would be receiving a

citation, and a license premise report would be filed.

On Sunday, July 28, 2024, at approximately 1:10 AM, PO REYES and PA PAGAN arrived at 551 W Historic Mitchell St, (Taqueria El TORO) in the City and County of Milwaukee, for an undercover underage sell of alcohol, to attempt to purchase alcohol. PA PAGAN entered the restaurant/bar at 1:11 AM, and was not carded by security and let in. PA PAGAN ordered a Corona beer, in a bottle, which cost \$4.00. The bartender/Server who served PA PAGAN was described as a W/F, wearing a red Guess shirt, blue jeans, and red shoes. After a few minutes passed PA PAGAN and PO REYES left the location.

PO MERRITT, PO RODRIGUEZ and I, entered the location, and identified the bartender/server that served PA PAGAN the drink as Gloria CASTILLO-CORTEZ (w/f, 2/24/92). We informed CASTILLO-CORTEZ she had sold a beer to an underage person. CASTILLO-CORTEZ stated she did not. CASTILLO-CORTEZ stated she believed some of her customers were young, however because they are regular, she did not card them or believe them when they say they are of age. We explained to CASTILLO-CORTEZ it is important to card her customers and make sure they are over the age of 21.

We spoke to the manager who was identified as Ximena PEREZ-IGNACIO (w/f, 12/13/02). PEREZ-IGNACIO stated she was not aware of what occurred and did not see her employee sell alcohol to an underage person. PEREZ-IGNACIO stated she will talk to the owners and informed them of the situation. We explained we will have to write up a license premise report for the violation which she understood. PEREZ-IGNACIO was cooperative throughout the investigation.

The owner was not the scene at the time of the violation.

A citation under citation# #M582CX0Q73 for City of Milwaukee ordinance 90-18-1-A-1 (Sale of alcohol to underage person) will be issued with a future court date.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


