January 25, 2007

On June 21, 2006, I was working under the hood of a vehicle when I felt something lightly hit my feet. I looked down and saw small pieces of what appeared to be gravel. I looked around the side of the car I was working on and realized it was coming from the street. There were two people using cutting machines. I went out to check on my vehicle, 2003 Chevy pickup, which was backed into a parking space. My Tonneau cover was full of pieces of road and my tailgate was pelted with small stone chips.
