REASON FOR REQUEST:

Joshua Yang, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a marked police vehicle that was traveling eastbound on West Center Street with its emergency lights and siren activated. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of North Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive and West Center Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding northbound on North Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the red traffic light, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. §62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Yang sustained a concussion, post traumatic headaches, cuts/bruises to his face and injuries to his right elbow, right knee and right hip. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$14,493.02.
