There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: See attached police report and letter from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections.



The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.



It was brought to my attention that Ms. Casey D'amato has applied for a Class D license from the City of Milwaukee. Ms. Casey D'amato is currently on an probation term which is scheduled to discharge on 6/12/2022 for the offense of possession of a controlled substance and possess drug paraphernalia.

This letter is to inform you that such a licensure would not be in violation of his/her rules/conditions of supervision. If circumstances change, we will take whatever action we deem appropriate, including action which may affect such licensure. This decision was made based in part, on the following information:

A - Residence Stability: offender has maintained residence stability (yes))

B - Reporting History: offender has maintained required contacts with agent (yes)
