Currently there are signs prohibiting left turns at all times northbound and southbound on North 35th Street at West Fond du Lac Avenue/West Burleigh Street. To improve local traffic circulation during lower traffic volume midday, late night, and weekend periods, signs will be installed to make this prohibition effective only from 6:30 AM to 9:00 AM and 2:30 PM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting so that you may support it to final passage.

NORTHBOUND ON NORTH PLANKINTON AVENUE
AT WEST CLYBOURN STREET

Dear Alderman Bauman:

Since West Clybourn Street is one-way westbound and North Plankinton Avenue is one-way northbound, left turns on red at the traffic signal at the intersection are permitted. The northbound approach on North Plankinton Avenue has a left turn only left lane and a shared left turn and through center lane. Vehicles in the shared left turn and through center lane would have to cross a moving lane on West Clybourn Street to make a left turn on red, creating an unsafe situation. Therefore, we recommend signs be installed to prohibit turns on red from the center lane northbound on North Plankinton Avenue at West Clybourn Street.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so you may support it to final passage.
