

Dear Mr. Equihua:

This is to notify you that on Wednesday, September 6, 2023, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council renewal with a fifteen (15) day suspension of the Food Dealer and Food Peddler licenses (vehicles 251 and 960) based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the written objections and inconsistent applicant testimony; for the premises located at 1704 S Pearl St. ("Mr. Taco").

On September 8, 2023, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Food Dealer and Food Peddler licenses (vehicles 251 and 960) in which the Committee recommended renewal with a fifteen (15) day suspension of the Food Dealer and Food Peddler licenses (vehicles 251 and 960) based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the written objections and inconsistent applicant's testimony. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, September 19, 2023, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee, you did not appear in person and you were not represented by a counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to renew with a fifteen (15) day suspension the Food Dealer and Food Peddler licenses (vehicles 251 and 960) based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the written objections and inconsistent applicant's testimony. Said suspension is effective between 12:01 a.m. on September 19, 2023 until 11:59 p.m on October 3, 2023.
