Substitute resolution approving levy-  
ing of assessments and construction of  
assessable public improvement projects  
at various locations and appropriating  
funds for these purposes with the City  
cost of these projects approved by this  
resolution is estimated to be \$289,300  
for a total estimated cost of \$349,100.

Whereas, The Common Council of  
the City of Milwaukee adopted prelimi-  
nary resolutions, determining it neces-  
sary and in the public interest to con-  
struct and levy special assessments for  
the following improvements:

5th Aldermanic District  
N. 87th St. - W. Burleigh St. to W.  
Concordia Ave. (ST21100121) File Num-  
ber 091341. Asphalt pavement resurfac-  
ing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk  
and driveway approaches where nec-  
essary, sodding (90-foot width of tree  
border area), and grading. (Assessable  
Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$8,500;  
Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving  
Fund - \$175,000). The total estimated  
cost for this project including the re-  
quested amount is \$221,500. This pro-  
ject is anticipated to be completed dur-  
ing the 2011 construction season.

6th Aldermanic District  
N. 6th St. - W. Garfield Ave. to W.  
North Ave. (ST211020102) File Number  
081390. Concrete pavement recon-  
struction, replace all curb and gutter,  
replace sidewalk and driveway ap-  
proaches where necessary, sodding  
(60-foot width of tree border area),  
and grading. Narrow roadway from 36  
feet to 32 feet. (Assessable Recon-  
struction Paving Fund - \$10,800; Non-  
assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund  
- \$95,000). The total estimated cost  
for this project including the requested  
amount is \$127,800. This project is an-  
ticipated to be completed during the  
2011 construction season.

in accordance with said report pursuant  
to Section 66.0703 and any other per-  
tinent sections of the Wisconsin Stat-  
utes and in the manner directed by Sec-  
tion 115.42 of the Milwaukee Code of  
Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper  
departments take such action as is re-  
quired of them to assess the abutting or  
adjacent properties and collect such as-  
sessment in the manner directed by Sec-  
tion 115.42 of the Milwaukee Code of  
Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City  
Comptroller is authorized and directed  
to transfer such funds which are avail-  
able for this purpose to the appropriate  
capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the projects  
do not involve any parcels of agricul-  
tural land which are eligible for de-  
ferred special assessments under the  
provisions of Section 14.30 of the Mil-  
waukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Depart-  
ment of Public Works is authorized to  
use the funding as specified in the  
above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects N.  
87th St. (ST21100121) and N. 6th St.  
(ST211020102) are to be allocated in  
the 2011 budget; and, be it

Further Resolved, That if surplus  
2010 funds become available, some or  
all of the 2011 budget projects may be  
funded with 2010 funds; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects N.  
87th St. (ST21100121) and N. 6th St.  
(ST211020102) will be billed after Janu-  
ary 1, 2013, but not before 12 months  
after the project contract has been  
completed.
