1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The Wisconsin Hazardous Materials Response System (WHMRS) Equipment Grant program was created by Wisconsin State Statute 323.70 (6) which authorizes the division to award grants to local agencies with which the division contracts with for HAZMAT Response System Services. The purpose of the grants is to fund the replacement of equipment used in emergency responses to releases of hazardous substances pursuant to the Contract for Wisconsin Hazardous Materials Response System Services. The WHMRS Committee conducted an inventory of the assets of each team statewide and developed the list of meters and detection equipment which have life cycles of 4 to 7 years that have exceeded their life cycle and need replacement.

Contributes to the Mayor's goal of providing safe and healthy neighborhoods through the provision of effective emergency response services.
