In the Department of Neighborhood Services:

One position of Code Enforcement Inspection Supervisor, Salary Grade 008, held by David Krey, is recommended for a title change to Nuisance and Environmental Health Manager, Salary Grade 008.

Two positions of Vector and Nuisance Control Supervisor, Salary Grade 006, held by Donald Schaewe, Jr. and James Igowsky, are recommended for title changes to Nuisance Control Supervisor, Salary Grade 006.

## Recommendations:

- A) Nuisance and Environmental Health Manager
- B) Nuisance Control Supervisor

Salary: No change for either position. (Title changes only.)

Rationale: Position A (Code Enforcement Inspection Supervisor). This position functions as the manager of the Nuisance and Environmental Health Division. Therefore, it would be appropriate to change the title of the position to Nuisance and Environmental Health Manager, which is more indicative of the actual duties and responsibilities of the position. Position B (Vector and Nuisance Control Supervisor). According to the department, the term "Vector" has been problematic because it is a word that is not readily known or understood by citizens and has prompted many questions. (A vector is an organism that carries a pathogen.) In addition, this position is assigned to the Nuisance Control Section and is responsible for the supervision of 17 Nuisance Control Officer positions. Nuisance Control supervisor is an accurate title that remains descriptive of the basic function of the position and resolves the problem encountered with the term "Vector".

History of Position: Position A (Code Enforcement Inspection Supervisor) was last studied in 1989 when it was reallocated from Salary Grade 007 to 008. Position B (Vector and Nuisance Control Supervisor) was last studied in 1998 when it was reclassified from Salary Grade 005 to 006.

Action Required: In the Salary Ordinance, under Salary Grade 006 delete the title "Vector and Nuisance Control Supervisor" and add the title "Nuisance Control Supervisor".

In the Positions Ordinance, Department of Neighborhood Services, Nuisance and Environmental Health Division, delete one position "Nuisance Control Manager (X)(Y) and add one position Nuisance and Environmental Health Manager (X)(Y).
