File # 011134 is a resolution authorizing acceptance and funding of the 2002 High-Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) project awards.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to continue its participation in a High-Intensity Drug Trafficking Area project. In this project, federal state and local law enforcement agencies work in multi-jurisdictional task forces, sharing intelligence, targeting major drug trafficking organizations and gangs, conducting investigations, and coordinating prosecutions.
- 2. This grant is continuing. Common Council File 001180 approved funding for federal fiscal year 2001 for MPD participation in the HIDTA project.

Discussion

- 1. The Office of National Drug Control Policy will reimburse the city for 50% of salaries and fringe benefits and 100% of overtime expenses for staff time contributed by the MPD for HIDTA efforts.
- 2. This grant funds five task forces relative to the HIDTA project:
 - HIDTA-South Side Gang Task Force
 - HIDTA-North Side Gangs Task Force
 - HIDTA-Intelligence Center
 - HIDTA-Heroin Task Force
 - HIDTA-Common Thread Task Force
- 3. The HIDTA project grant funds the following positions:
 - 9 Detectives
 - 1 Captain
 - 1 Lieutenant
 - 6 Police Officers
- 4. This grant budget also provides for miscellaneous expenses including parking, undercover vehicle leasing, and confidential funds.
- 5. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total of this grant is \$1,830,669. \$792,854 is to be provided by the grantor and \$1,037,815 is provided by the city.
- 2. The city portion of this grant has been budgeted in the MPD 2002 operations budget.
