In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

DO NOT PAINT DIRECTLY ON THE BUILDING. This must be installed as fabric or attached panels on the building. Painting directly on the building is prohibited. Mounting posts for the art shall be drilled into mortar joints only and not into the face of any brick or stone.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
