

# AART 2023 PB RULEBOOK

## Goals

- Encourage intergenerational Community Engagement from residents on the NWS in AART's PB process.
- Create a blueprint of a community led PB process that other organizations and people in other cities could follow.
- Build 1-2 leadership skills on the steering committee
- Create opportunities for residents to grow in writing a proposal and submitting a proposal.
- Fund at 4 projects from writing a proposal through execution.
- Grow AART's base and membership by 10 throughout this PB process.

## Timeline

- March-April 2023: Design the Process
- June-mid July 2023: Collect Ideas/Develop Proposals
  - Host 1 event.
- Mid-July-End first week of August- look over proposals
- August-September 2023: Vote
- October 2023: Announcement
- October-December- Implement Winning Proposals
- November 2023: Evaluate the Process

## Who Can Participate

- Who can submit proposals?
  - **Residents of NSW 18+**
  - **Churches, Organizations or collectives NSW**
  - **Businesses serving NWS**
  - **AART Members but project must be based on NSW**
- Who can vote?
  - Proposal of 14 years old and older
  - Black Residents on NWS

## Project Eligibility

Projects have to meet the following criteria to be eligible for funding:

- Up to \$10,000
- Project that deal with neighborhood safety and neighborhood wellness
- No projects that work with police.
