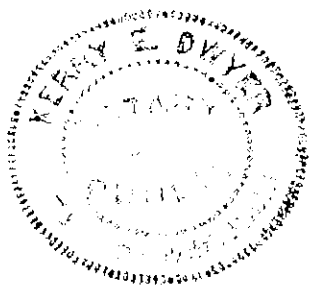

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced at the February 10, 2009 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

Substitute ordinance relating to the First Amendment to a Detailed Planned Development known as Mercy Housing, to increase the number of residential units from 89 to 91, on land located on the North Side of West Windlake Avenue and East of South 13th Street, in the 12th Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Common Council"), do ordain as follows:

Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("Code") a new section to read as follows:

Section 295-907(2)(c)0141

(1) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907 of the Code relating to the establishment of planned development districts, the Common Council approves the subject amended Detailed Planned Development, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.

(2) The zoning map reaffirms the zoning for the area bounded and described as follows:

The zoning line within West Windlake Avenue, the centerline of West Grant Street, the zoning line within South 13th Street, a line 276 feet South and parallel to the south line of West Becker Street and the northeast line of the property at 1220 West Windlake Avenue extended.

(3) The requirements set forth in said amended detailed plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, constitute the zoning regulations for the area contained in such planned development district described, provided further, that the effect of the approval of such amended detailed plan is that such plan shall limit and control construction, location, use and operation of all land and structures included within the amended detailed plan to all conditions and limitations set forth in such amended detailed plan.

Part 2. Any persons, firm, company or corporation owning, controlling or managing any building or premises wherein or whereon there shall be placed or there exists anything in violation of the terms of this ordinance; or who shall build contrary to the plans or specifications submitted to and ap-

proved by the Commissioner of the Department of City Development, or any person, firm, company or corporation who shall omit, neglect or refuse to do any act required in this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 200-19 of the Code.

Part 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions. The Common Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases or other portions be declared void or invalid.

Notice is hereby further given that the foregoing matter will be given a public hearing by the Committee on Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Wednesday, April 8, 2009 at 9:00 A.M. pursuant to the provision of Sub-Section (2)(d) of Section 62.23 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.

PLEASE NOTE: a) Members of the Common Council, and members of its Standing Committees who are not members of this Committee, may attend this meeting to participate or to gather information. Therefore, notice is given that this meeting may constitute a meeting of the Common Council or any of its Standing Committees, and must be noticed as such, although they will not take any formal action at this meeting.

b) If you have difficulty with the English language, you may bring an interpreter with you, at your own expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in the hearing.
