REASON FOR REQUEST:

Emory McPherson, Jr., a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City-owned vehicle that was traveling northbound on North 7th Street. After Mr. McPherson stopped his vehicle in traffic at the intersection of North 7th Street and West North Avenue, the uninsured motorist, who was also traveling northbound on North 7th Street, failed to yield the right-of-way and rear-ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. McPherson, Jr. sustained injuries to his neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$43,182.31.
