This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 10/08/2020 at 6:15pm officers were dispatched to Pick N Save at 3701 S 27th St for a Retail Theft. The officers spoke with the manager, who stated the suspect was no longer on scene.
2. On 11/24/2020 at 7:30pm officers were dispatched to a Theft complaint at Pick N. Save, 3701 S 27th St. The officer spoke with the manager, who stated a subject exited the store with a small basket of merchandise that she did not pay for. The manager gave the officer a license plate number, which did not list to the described vehicle. The manager could not access the video but stated she would drop off a copy of the video at a later time.
3. On 11/24/2020 at 7:49pm officers were dispatched to a Theft complaint at Pick N. Save, 3701 S 27th St. The officers spoke with the manager, who pointed out a subject to the officers that was observed concealing meat in his jacket. The officers stopped the subject and issued him a citation.

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4. On 12/24/20 at 11:30am, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Injured/Sick complaint. Officers were advised an intoxicated subject was being conveyed to the hospital for treatment.

5. On 01/01/21 at 7:31pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Trouble with Subject complaint. Security advised officers they wanted a known subject that was not allowed on the premise to be removed. No violations were observed.
6. On 01/05/21 at 3:25pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Fight complaint. Officers were directed to the men's restroom where one of the subjects involved was. The subject stated he was in a fight with his brother and did not want police assistance. The officers requested medical treatment for a laceration to the subject's nose. No violations were found.
7. On 02/13/21 at 6:30pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Threat complaint. Officers were advised by the manager that an employee's father continuously calls the store to check on her, as there are trust issues. The father became irate when he was told by an employee they did not know the whereabouts of his daughter. The father then made physical threats to harm the manager. The manager did not want citations issued. The subject was advised not to enter or contact the store via telephone.
8. On 03/01/21 at 6:35pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Trouble with Subject complaint. Officers were advised by management a subject was causing a disturbance in the store by yelling and throwing items. The subject was arrested and issued a citation.
9. On 03/05/21 at 4:10pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Threat complaint. Officers were advised by management that an employee's father continuously calls the store and verbally threatens the staff. The caller was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct.
10. On 03/06/21 at 9:40pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Threat complaint. Officers were advised by management that known subjects, who had previously been banned, entered the store and took merchandise valued at approximately \$75 and walked past the last point of purchase without paying. No violations were found.
11. On 03/14/21 at 10:50am, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for an attempted theft. Officers were advised a known subject entered the store and attempted to steal items. The subject fled the scene, however, was later apprehended by Police and arrested for Theft and Trespassing.
12. On 03/14/21 at 3:20pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for an attempted Theft. Officers were advised a subject entered the store and concealed alcohol and fled the store. The alcohol was later retrieved by security.
13. On 03/19/21 at 4:04pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Retail Theft. Officers were advised by management a subject entered the store and attempted to steal items. Once confronted by security the subject returned the items but became irate and began yelling, causing a disturbance. The subject was already gone on police arrival. No violations were found.

Officers were advised by the manager that a customer entered the store and told another customers children she would fight them. The subject was confronted by management, asked to sign a form banning her from the store due to her behavior. The customer signed it and exited the store, however, stood outside the property. The officers interviewed the subject, who was known to them as having mental issues. The subject stated she was only playing with the kids and voluntarily left the scene.
15. On 04/28/21 at 1:50pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Retail Theft. Officers were advised that a subject entered the store and placed approximately \$400 worth of merchandise in a shopping cart, then left the store past the last point of purchase, without paying. The subject then grabbed whatever items he could from the cart and fled in a vehicle. Management was cooperative, allowing officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
16. On 06/12/21 at 3:12pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Theft. Officers were advised two subjects entered the liquor department and filled a backpack with liquor despite multiple employees present and requests for them to return the liquor. The subjects were followed outside by security and upon fleeing in a vehicle, threw a can of Red Bull at one of the employees. Employees were cooperative with the investigation and provided surveillance video of the incident.
17. On 07/02/21 at 5:05pm, officers were dispatched to Pick N Save, 3701 S. 27th St, for a Trouble with Subject. Officers were advised a known subject entered the liquor store and was observed concealing a bottle on his person. The subject was confronted and fled the store. No violations were found.

After speaking with Seiko for some time, he decided that he wanted some medical attention for his nose. Once Curtis arrived, Seiko said that he wanted to go to the hospital.

This report is written by PO LAUX assigned to the Sixth District, early shift. On Saturday, 02-13-21 at 7:05 PM Officers LAUX and ZINGSHEIM (SQD 6231) were dispatched to a Threat Complaint at Pick N Save Address: 3701 S. 27th Street.

Upon arrival, we spoke to Store Manager Jamie R. GENTHERT (W/F, 12-01-85, Address: 3701 S. 27th St. Phone: 281-2900). She stated she has a Store Employee Anna M. ALLEN (B/F, 02-09-04, Address: 1561 S. 6th St. Phone: 676-0118) that works in the produce section. Every day her Father Demetrious O. OVER (B/M, 10-23-81, Address: 1561 S. 6th St. Phone: 676-8297) calls the store over and over again, checking on Anna. Demetrius does not trust Anna, when she out of the house.

On 02-13-21 Demetrius called the Pick N Save, and asked Anna. Another manager stated they didn't know where Anna was. He hung up, and called a few minutes later. Jamie answered the phone, and stated she will find Anna. Demetrius told Jamie, he thought the managers were giving him, "The run around." Demetrius stated there was an emergency, and he had to pick up Anna early from work. Demetrius then made a threat to, "Fuck up Jamie and fuck up the store." Jamie wasn't happy with the threat, and the police were called.

Anna was located at the Panda Express Address: 3606 S. 27th Street. Officers DORSEY and DOXTATOR were dispatched to the Panda Express for a welfare check. I spoke to Anna. She stated she was at work, and Demetrius called her, and stated he was in the parking lot waiting for her. Anna stated she was embarrassed because of her dad, and ran to the Panda Express. Anna didn't want Demetrius to go inside the store and create problems.

Anna's Mother Marian (nmi) ALLEN (B/F, 06-16-84, Address: 1561 S. 6th St. Phone: 676-0118) arrived on scene to pick up Anna. Officer ZINGSHEIM and I explained to Marian, she needed to talk to Demetrius, and tell him not to contact the Pick N Save by phone or go inside the Pick N Save. If he does, he will be issued citations regarding any incidents he creates. Jamie did not want any citations issued at this time.

Employees were cooperative and no violations were observed during this incident.

Upon arrival, I interviewed Jamie R GENTHERT, w/f, 12-01-85 who is the HR Assistant Store Manager at Pick N Save. GENTHERT stated that she was working when she was alerted of a potential shoplifter in the liquor department. GENTHERT stated she went to check on the situation and observed two subjects taking alcohol and putting them into a backpack. GENTHERT described the subjects as follows: Suspect #1: W/M, 30-40yo, heavy build, black covid mask, black baseball cap, white "Coors" tshirt, black shorts, black shoes, black backpack. Suspect #2: W/F, 20-30yo, slender build, black covid mask, Green #17 Packer jersey with "Adams" on the back, black Nike sandals with white "swoosh", various unknown leg tattoos. GENTHERT stated that she recognized Suspect #1 as someone who shoplifted there before and assaulted her (IR #21-152-0112). GENTHERT stated he has also targeted other Pick N Save stores in the area in the past. GENTHERT stated that the Suspect #1 observed her but continued to load the backpack and then walk out the door along with Suspect #2. GENTHERT followed him to the vehicle where Suspect #1 got into the driver's seat and Suspect #2 got into the front passenger seat. GENTHERT had her cell phone out and was taking pictures and video of the Suspect vehicle (Silver GMC Envoy with an "REO Motors" tag instead of a plate on the rear bumper. On the rear of the vehicle was three silver/white stars, Green Bay Packer "G", pink "Princess" sticker, "Glove" Brewer logo, "Green Bay Packer" sticker). As GENTHERT was taking video, Suspect 1 got into the vehicle and threw a full can of Red Bull at GENTHERT that did not make contact with her and landed on the ground. The Suspect then drove the vehicle s/b through the parking lot. GENTHERT showed me the video and pictures of the vehicle that she took with her cell phone of what occurred outside of the store in the parking lot.

GENTHERT resides at 1328 Madison Av, in South Milwaukee. The information listed in the persons tab autocorrects it to 1328 W Madison St, Milwaukee on multiple attempts.

GENTHERT stated that 8-1.75 liter bottles of Jagermeister valued at \$33.99 each were taken as well as 3-1.75 liter bottles of Jim Beam. Total value of items taken was \$400.89.

I interviewed Joseph A REUTER, w/m, 7-24-92 who is the Store Director at Pick N Save. REUTER stated

that a cashier called telling him of a Suspicious Person in the liquor department. REUTER stated that him and GENTHERT went into the liquor department and GENTHERT was first to make contact with the suspects by the cooler. GENTHERT comes back around and advises him that there is a confirmed shoplifting in progress. REUTER approached Suspect #1 and stated "Come on, give us back the alcohol". Suspect 1 responded, "Get the fuck out of my way" as he continued to load the cart and then the backpack. Suspect 1 and Suspect 2 then left the store and walked outside. REUTER followed them along with GENTHERT. As GENTHERT was getting the vehicle information, REUTER stated that Suspect 1 threw a Red Bull can at GENTHERT and then drove away. REUTER stated that Suspect 1 seemed 'very comfortable' and 'relaxed' while he was stealing from the store.

I interviewed Dylan J FLANAGAN, w/m, 5-30-95, who is a Bakery Manager at Pick N Save. FLANAGAN stated she was working in the Bakery Department when there was a "Mr Mitchell" code over the PA. FLANAGAN stated that this is code for help. FLANAGAN arrived in the liquor department and GENTHERT was motioning him to come over. As he got closer, he observed Suspect 2 walk past him and then Suspect 1. Suspect 1 had a bottle of liquor in his hand and had the middle finger extended. Suspect 1 and Suspect 2 walked to the vehicle ignoring requests for them to stop and return the alcohol. Suspect 1 responded, "You can't do anything". Suspect 1 and Suspect 2 got into the vehicle as GENTHERT was recording the vehicle information. FLANAGAN observed a can of Red Bull thrown "hard" through the passenger window which came within a foot of GENTHERT's head. The vehicle then fled S/B through the parking lot.

I interviewed Donna M OSEGARD, w/f, 4-16-74, who is a Customer Service Manager at Pick N Save. OSEGARD stated that she heard the "Mr Mitchell" code over the PA followed by her name specifically being called for help. OSEGARD stated it took her awhile to get there and met up with the subjects as they were outside getting in the vehicle. She observed a can of Red Bull thrown out of the window by an unknown person towards GENTHERT. The vehicle then fled S/B through the parking lot. FLANAGAN then picked up the can of Red Bull, poured out the remaining liquid and threw away the can.

I interviewed Brittany M PAGE, U/F, 9-6-94, who works as a Cashier at Pick N Save. I interviewed PAGE via telephone as her shift had ended prior to my arrival. PAGE stated that she was helping a customer when she observed Suspect 1 and Suspect 2 walk in the store with empty backpacks. PAGE stated she informed GENTHERT about this and went back to helping the customer. PAGE stated she observed GENTHERT following Suspect 1 and Suspect 2 out of the store telling them to put the merchandise down. The suspects continued to walk out the door into the parking lot. PAGE stated she did not see anything else as she had stayed inside the store.

I contacted Acting LT, SGT TAYLOR, who stated CIB would not be responding.

I am a trained CST and I took 13 digital photographs at 6:30PM.

The video of the incident was put on inventory at District 6 (INV #21021730). This includes video from inside the store and from GENTHERT's phone (which is a .mov file).

This case is pending.


