### INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by PO Jack CARLONI assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift.

On Wednesday September 6th, 2023, assigned to Squad 2455 (myself and PO Gino HERNANDEZ) responded to a "Fire" at the location of 1942 S Muskego Ave., which is in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival at approximately 12:14 we made contact with Milwaukee Fire department at the 1942 S Muskego Ave. The residence was a vacant and boarded up property. The residence was unoccupied, and no occupants live at the location. Upon arrival I observed large visible flames and heavy damage to the residence.

An unknown anonymous caller stated that they observed a male enter the residence and then exit the residence. After the male exited the residence, the caller observed smoke coming from the upstairs. The male subject stayed until he saw the smoke and then ran away. Caller was very uncooperative and refused to give information.

Fire Inspector LT SCOTT was on scene. Fire Inspector LT Scott stated the fire is a 1 alarm fire + one extra engine. Rescue 1, Med 3, Engines 23, 26, 28 and 33, Trucks 2 and 9, Air Supply 2 and the supervisor are on scene.

There were no people injured from the fire at the unoccupied residence.

The property tax key # is 4704042100 and the owner is listed as Julio EQUIHUA.

The only report of suspicious activity for the fire was the anonymous callers' statement. The cause of the fire is unknown at this moment. Fire inspector LT Scott stated that there was no odor of accelerants at the residence and did not note in other reason of suspicious activity.

Milwaukee Fire Department as well as officers searched the residence after the fire was distinguished. Officers and MFD did not locate any items of evidential value inside of the residence.

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Damage estimated at \$100,000 to building. The building was estimated to be a complete loss.

FI Jennifer BEAMON responded to the scene took photos of the scene, see FI BEAMON's supplemental report regarding.

I conducted canvass of the area. I made contact with the resident of 1937 W Muskego Ave, identified as Alicia BENITEZ (H/F 08/15/1976). BENITEZ's residence has two cameras at the exterior of the residence that face east of the residence facing 1942 S Muskego Ave. I review the front door camera footage and the camera on the southeast conner, which did not show any suspicious activity coming or going to the residence. The camera footage is motion activated and only captured officers and firefighters that were on scene.

I made contact with the residents 1932 W Muskego Ave, who were outside of their residence. The residents stated that they did not observe any activity at 1942 S Muskego Ave and stated that they came outside when they saw all of the fire fighters and officers outside. The occupants of 1932 W Muskego Ave did not want to provide their information to officers.

PO Gino HERNANDEZ stated that he made contact with the resident of 1943 S Muskego Ave. PO HERNANDEZ spoke with the resident who stated that they did not observe any signs of activity from the 1942 S Muskego Ave and that they did not have any working cameras on their residence. PO HERNANDEZ stated that the resident of 1943 S Muskego Ave did not want to provide their information.
