There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: Objections to the granting this loading zone due to land use and parking availability in the block where the loading zone is requested, the roadway geometrics in the block in which the loading and unloading zone is requested, the requested hours of the loading zone and the impact of the loading zone on the surrounding neighborhood.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

PLEASE NOTE: Upon reasonable notice, efforts will be made to accommodate the needs of disabled individuals through sign language interpreters or other auxiliary aids. To whom it may concern:

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 06/28/2022 at 01:15 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

To whom it may concern:


I wanted to provide an explanation for the reason for my request. The block that I live on mostly consists of homeowners; however, the house diagonally across from me has been rented out as of last summer. Their garage caught on fire a couple years back while the owners were residing in the property and, unfortunately, the owners decided not to have it repaired. The renters own a business, and since last summer when they moved in, they have acquired a total of six vehicles (I believe) for their transportation service that they park on the street.

I am a part of a non-profit organization and I regularly collect donations for our Global Impact committee that I am a part of. The numerous vehicles constantly parked in front of my house has caused a disturbance in my ability to do so conveniently. Because of how our area is set up, my side of the street is a short block that only consists of four houses. When their employees pick up the vans for work, they leave their vehicles in front of my house frequently due to the close proximity, so I almost always have vehicles parked in front of my house (either the personal vehicles belonging to the house, the work vans, or the employee's cars). If it was a periodic situation, this wouldn't be an issue. However, most days there are normally cars/trucks/vans parked on both sides of my driveway all day. I prefer to not have random people pull into my drive-way for drops off as I've had an incident of someone's wheel axle breaking and their car was stranded in my driveway. Ultimately, I had to use my AAA to have the car removed as the owner of the vehicle was not able to do so in a timely manner.

Most of the people dropping off items consist of women of an older age. Having to carry boxes from a further distance may often times present physical issues for them and I am not always available to come out to assist. I am not requesting the loading zone on behalf of my organization but rather to simplify the pick-up/drop off for the older females coming to make donations. In the 10yrs that have lived in my home, this has never been an issue as most people on my block park in their garage, driveway, or slab.

The daytime loading zone would not hinder parking availability for my neighbors, not even the house that the numerous vehicles mentioned above belong to. They would still have the option of parking on their side of the street, further down my way, or even simply parking in the opposite direction to the left of their home. I am willing to pay for the loading zone out of my own pocket to simplify the process of collecting the donations as it was prior to this issue.
