In 2019, under the STRONG Neighborhoods Plan, the Neighborhood Improvement Development Corporation (NIDC) completed the following:

- **Community Outreach Events:** Staff attended 50+ events promoting STRONG Neighborhoods Plan programs.

Homebuyer Assistance Program (SNP-HBA)

Rental Rehabilitation Expansion Program (SNP-RR)

4 units approved/closed (YTD) \$59,996 of city investment (YTD) \$144,829 of leveraged funds (YTD) 3 units (applications in process)
