Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend extending this parking restriction to increase visibility at the intersection.

Legislation will be prepared for consideration at the next Public Safety and Health Committee meeting to install the parking restriction.

This is in response to your request on behalf of a local business owner to implement the above-captioned parking restriction changes.

Our Traffic Engineering staffs has investigated this request and found that the no parking restriction on the west side of North 59th Street north of West Blue Mound Road can be removed, thereby restoring additional on-street parking in this area and still allow traffic flow on the roadway. However, since North 59th Street has a 30 feet street width, we recommend the installation of a "No Parking December 1<sup>st</sup> to March 1<sup>st</sup> parking restriction to maintain a drivable roadway width for emergency vehicles during the winter months.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety and Health Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
