There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

**Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.**

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

Good morning all,

I received another call from the same constituent ( ) who wishes to remain anonymous, and said that the concerns are still present. Alderman Murphy would like to prevent these issues from growing into even bigger concerns. I have copied several different departments on this email to look into, and I ask that each corresponding department please respond to myself and Alderman Murphy about what can be done:

- **MPD** – Captain, please keep an eye on this property. ( ) told me that MPD has been there several times since he's been staying there, and that the MPD was most recently there yesterday for a violence situation. Please let me know when this property is deemed a nuisance per the 80-10 policy. ( ) stated that he is told by staff that it is their policy not to call MPD about criminal activity/complaints, so there may be more serious concerns we are not privy to. Have there been calls about prostitution, drug dealing, and drug usage?
- **DNS Commercial / DNS Special Enforcement** – Please conduct extensive inspections on the property, both interior and exterior, per Alderman Murphy. ( ) informed me there's an inspection tomorrow for hotel rooms that Singh chooses. Why are these rooms chosen by Singh and not by the inspector? Wouldn't this give him ample time to address any violations before the City finds them? Please notify me when these inspections occur and what is found.
- **Community Advocates** – ( ) said that he has been living at the American Inn for the last 6 months and he does not get rental receipts showing that he's paid up. He also gets paid under the minimum wage, 8-9 hours a day, and that he only gets \$1 for every room that he cleans. What, if any, violations are at play here? What rights does ( ) have as a long-term occupant of the hotel?
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- **Licenses** – Please add this concern to the records for both the American Inn (6798 W. Appleton Ave) and the Economy Inn (7284 W. Appleton Ave).

( ) is in the process of sending me pictures. Once he does that, I will forward those photos to everyone listed in this thread.

Thank you all for your work in remedying this situation.

Good Afternoon,

Our office just received some disturbing reports from an anonymous constituent (wishes very much to remain anonymous for his own safety) at the American Hotel at 6798 W Appleton and the Economy Inn at 7284 W Appleton Ave, Milwaukee relating to the property owner, Mr. Jack Singh. According to the constituent there was a physical altercation at the Economy Inn resulting in a large amount of blood right outside the door of the motel forming a trail out back to the alley; also at the Economy, according to the source a man who has stayed at the hotel for a long period of time was intoxicated yesterday when he threatened a 5 and 7 year old with a knife. Additionally, both the American and Economy motels see prostitution, drug usage, and drug dealing occurring daily. Further, the source claims the "standard practice" is for the employees and owners to turn a blind eye to the illegal and criminal activity, and workers have been told to never contact the police. Please enforce as necessary--if you have any questions, feel free to email or call our office at 286 2074.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/6/2017 at 11:00 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.  
**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**


