Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The clerk provided all the business licenses and a Class D operator's license. The officer observed a pack of cigarettes next to the register but the clerk denied they were for selling single cigarettes. The officer advised that a secret shopper may come in a check to see if the business is selling singles cigarettes in the future.
- 6. On 05/14/2019 at 9:04pm officers observed subjects exiting the store at 103 E. Keefe Av. The officers conducted a licensed premise check because this location has a Class A Malt license. The clerk stated the business stopped selling alcohol at 9:00pm but remained open for food sales until 10:00pm. He stated the lights to the beer cooler were turned off at 9 but the coolers were not locked. The owner responded while the officers were on scene and was cooperative.

This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5 Late Power Shift, Tavern Squad 5468. with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 05-14-19 at or about 9:04 p.m., while driving west bound on E. Keefe Ave., we observed 3 to 4 people exiting All For Us convenience store, located at 103 E. Keefe Ave., which is a licensed premise in the city of Milwaukee.

Believing that the store should have been closed at 9:00 p.m., we conducted a licensed premise check. Upon entering the store, Kamaliit SINGH (w/m 04-02-73) was working the counter, while Joseph I. BOGAN (b/m 11-25-79) was working the inside of the store.

Upon entering the store, we informed the two that we were there to inspect the licenses. We found that they do have a Class A License, which has a closing time of 9:00 p.m. Upon further inspection, we found that the business has a Food Dealers license (9391-8) which is valid until 10-31-19 and has a closing time of 10:00 p.m.

I asked BOGAN if the store was still selling beer and he informed me that at 9:00 p.m., he turns off the lights to the cooler in which the beer is stored, but that the doors to the coolers are not locked. The store makes sure that beer is not sold after 9:00 p.m. He also went on to tell me that they begin to close the store after 9:00 p.m., but still sell food related items until 10:00 p.m.

While at the store, the owner Baljinder S. DHILLON (w/m 04/15/77) arrived. DHILLON is the owner of the Hometown Gas Station at 3476 N. Holton St. and was alerted to our being at the store. DHILLON arrived a short time after we began checking the licenses.

All the employees and DHILLON were cooperative with us during our checking of the licenses and closed the store shortly after we were completed with the license inspection.



This report is written by PO Penny MONREAL, assigned to the License Investigation Unit.

On Thursday, July 11, 2019, PO Denise RUEDA and I were on patrol conducting license premise checks at various establishments throughout the City of Milwaukee. At approximately 10:20A, PO RUEDA and I entered All For Us, located at 103 E. Keefe Av. Officers introduced ourselves to the sole employee on scene, who was identified by Wisconsin Identification Card as: Kamaljit SINGH A/M 04/02/73. Since this is a Class A establishment, and was open for business with alcohol offered for sale, officers requested to see SINGH's Class D Operator License. SINGH stated he did have one, however, it expired years ago and he did not renew it. A check with LIRA (License Information and Reporting Administration) revealed SINGH had applied 3/8/16, however, had never paid for the license. SINGH was advised to cease all alcohol sales until and if a valid Class D Operator or the agent was on scene. SINGH stated he would go take care of his license immediately.

I was unable to contact the agent: Blajinder S. DHILLON, therefore, a voicemail was left regarding the circumstances.

This report is written by PO Penny Monreal assigned to License Investigation Unit.

On Monday, March 4, 2019 at 10:10a.m., I conducted a license premise check at All For Us Food, located at 103 E. Keefe Ave. This was in regards to an anonymous call of single cigarette sales. I introduced myself to the sole employee (Viney VIJ) on scene and requested to see the business's licenses, as well as his Class D Operator. He provided me with a valid Class A, Food, Tobacco, and his Class D license. I advised VIJ of the reason for my investigation, however, he denied any single cigarette sales. I then observed a box of coins right next to the register and VIJ appeared slightly nervous. I lifted a piece of paper that was 1/2 covering the box and observed an empty box of Newport 100's and another open box containing only 12 cigarettes. VIJ denied they were used to sell single cigarettes and stated they belonged to one of the employee. I advised VIJ that I suspected they were selling single cigarettes and also advised that we do undercover buys with youth and to cease sales of singles if they were. VIJ assured me they were not selling single cigarettes.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 10/1/2019 at 10:00 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.




We conducted a walk through with owner, Lakhwinder Singh and wife Jaspreet Kaur.



- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


