DENNIS BIDDLE

was honored during the annual Negro Leagues Tribute event on July 11, 2025 at Miller Park during the Brewers – Nationals game, part of the 2025 stadium legacy celebration weekend

WHEREAS, Dennis Biddle was born on June 24, 1935, in Magnolia, Arkansas, and excelled in athletics at a young age by lettering baseball, basketball, track, and football at Columbia County High School, before graduating at age 17 to pursue his dream of playing professional baseball; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Biddle debuted as a pitcher for the Chicago American Giants in the Negro Leagues in 1953, winning 15 games in his rookie season with a notable victory over Gerald "Lefty" McKinnis, earning him the nickname "The Man Who Beat The Man Who Beat The Man" and was later recognized as the youngest player to join the Negro Leagues; and

WHEREAS, After a career ending injury while trying out for the Chicago Cubs in 1954, Dennis Biddle turned tragedy into purpose by dedicating his life to decades of honoring the legacy of Negro League players through speaking at schools, colleges, and military bases; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Biddle has inspired and educated tens of thousands of students across the nation and abroad with his Negro League Traveling Exhibits and Presentations, using sports as a platform to uplift messages of civil rights and Black excellence; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Biddle's lifelong dedication to education and justice earned him numerous honors, including induction into the Wall of Honor at Milwaukee's Miller Park in 2006 and authorship of Secrets of the Negro Baseball Leagues, demonstrating his status as not only a sportsman but a cultural leader; now, therefore, be it
