Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 070251

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is the Common Council Resolution File Number 070251, being an amendment to a special privilege to P&H Mining Equipment, Inc. for change of ownership of communications cables and for addition of a turnstile on a concrete platform encroaching into the public right-of-way for the premises at 4107 West Orchard Street.

Harnischfeger Corporation requested permission for underground conduit and overhead cables for communication purposes. Permission for said items was granted in 1983 under Common Council Resolution File Number 83-899-a. A site visit revealed the presence of a turnstile on a concrete platform in the south sidewalk area of West Orchard Street.

We are not aware that the presence of said items has had or will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will amend the ownership of the above special privilege and will formally allow said items to continue to occupy the public right-of-way.
