There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer(PO) Yousef HAMDAN, assigned to Squad 4467 (Tavern Car) at District Four on Late Power Shift with PO Brandi POORT.

On Friday May 23, 2025, at approximately, 10:17 Pm while in full duty uniform and in marked squad car 65438, and equipped with an axon body worn camera, PO POORT, and I were dispatched to the address of 8762 N Granville Rd, located in The City and County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin for a report of a Battery in Progress.

Upon our arrival we observed a patron approach us in the parking lot and state the bartender and the owner of the Bar had an altercation regarding her credit card that was lost at the bar by the bartender. The patron stated they eventually found her credit card and returned it to her. The patron stated she was dissatisfied with the service and will not be returning to the establishment. The patron stated that the altercation between the bartender and the owner caused her to fear for her safety. While we talking to the Patron the owner of the bar had everyone leave and turned off the lights and began closing, we then made our way inside the bar and spoke with the owner who identified herself with her Wisconsin Drivers License as Kelly Jo. WESTERHAUSEN (B/F, 01-06-1978).

WESTRHAUSEN stated that 3 credit cards had fallen between the counter and the register and were later found. WESTERHAUSEN stated the person who initially called Police had walked out on a tab last weekend, when confronted about her balance she became defensive and stated she payed her bill on Thursday May 22, 2025. WESTERHAUSEN stated she was not at the location on that date and was unsure if the tab was payed. WESTERHAUSEN stated that the Patron left on todays date without settling her tab and she does not want her back in the bar and will look into getting a restraining order.

The Food, Bartender, and Entertainment Licenses are all valid until December 29, 2025. Licenses were posted in plain view on the wall by the kitchen entrance. Hours of operation for the bar are until 11:00 PM and until 2 AM for the Restaurant WESTERHAUSEN was cooperative with officer.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 12/2/2025 at 9:30 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
