REASON FOR REQUEST:

Teri Huff, a City of Milwaukee Inspector, was in the scope of her employment and operating a vehicle that was traveling northbound on N. 51<sup>st</sup> Street. As the claimant's vehicle entered the intersection of N. 51<sup>st</sup> Street and W. Clarke Street, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding eastbound on W. Clarke Street at a high rate of speed, failed to stop for the stop sign and struck the claimant's vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Ms. Huff sustained injuries to her right ankle, right wrist, and neck. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$6,201.83.
