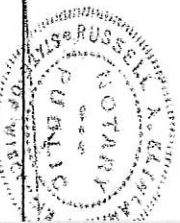

Establishment of the boundary of Neighborhood Improvement District No. 7 (Harambee) and approval of its Initial Operating Plan for the area generally bounded by Capitol Drive on the north, Center Street on the south, I-43 on the west and North Holton Street on the east, excluding properties included in the Historic King Drive Business Improvement District and the Riverworks Business Improvement District.
