Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Chris Ederesinghe. The claim is in the amount of \$486.18 including \$13.18 in disbursements for 4.30 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officer on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

reports that it was at this time that the complainant then made an obscene gesture with his finger. Officer EDERESINGHE states at this time determination was made to stop the complainant. Officer EDERESINGHE states that while behind the complainant he did activate his red lights, but the complainant, however, refused to pull over. He states that the complainant did eventually stop at which time he approached the drivers side of the vehicle. He states that he then told the complainant to put the vehicle in park and to shut off the engine. Officer EDERESINGHE states that the complainant ignored his request to put the vehicle in park and shut off the engine. The request was made two additional times. Officer EDERESINGHE states that he then opened the drivers side door, reached in, and turned off the engine. Officer EDERESINGHE states that the complainant then said words to the effect, "this is West Allis, you have no jurisdiction, you have no probable cause." EDERESINGHE states that he then requested the complainant's drivers license at which point the complainant replied, "you have no idea who the fuck I am. My dad is lieutenant of this city (referring to West Allis)." Officer EDERESINGHE states after repeated efforts to calm down the complainant he then determined that the complainant would be arrested for Disorderly Conduct. He states that as he and his partner attempted to handcuff the complainant he then "stiffened up" requiring his hands to be forced behind his back to affect the handcuffing process. Officer EDERESINGHE indicates that the complainant made no mention of suffering injuries during the course of his arrest. Further, if injury did occur, it was not his intent.

During the course of this investigation a West Allis police officer, Officer Michael WROBLEWSKI, who arrived on the scene was interviewed in addition to neighbors and that of Officer EDERESINGHE'S partner, Stephanie JAMES. Said interviews did not result in the substantiation of excessive force while executing the arrest of the complainant.

CONCLUSION:

On Wednesday, April 12, 2000 and Monday, April 17, 2000, this case was reviewed in the office of the District Attorney. It was on the latter date that ADA Thomas MCADAMS did decline to pursue a charge of Battery against Officer EDERESINGHE. ADA MCADAMS

SUMMARY CIU#00-069

offered insufficient evidence to prove a case against Officer EDERESINGHE beyond a reasonable doubt. It is for said reasons that this incident will be cleared as warrant refused.
