Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 09/07/22 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 206 W. Layton Avenue for Building Code Violations.

2. On 09/13/23, follow-up was conducted for a stolen auto at 1434 S. Muskego Avenue (MKE Towing). Officers interviewed the owner who stated that he received a request from his dispatch center (located in Pakistan) for a tow and that the key holder would be on scene. When the wrecker arrived, there was no key holder and the owner told the driver to tow the vehicle anyway. The vehicle was dropped off on a public street. There was no information obtained of who the person was that requested the tow. Officers informed the owner of the following violations; failure to gather information before towing a vehicle, failure to have an RST license, towing vehicles to a location not on file with the city, and pricing not posted in public view. The owner was cited for towing a vehicle without first obtaining adequate identification.

This report is submitted by Officer Carlos Felix assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Day Shift.

On September 7, 2023, a victim reported her vehicle stolen. It was discovered the victim's car was taken with a tow truck owned by MKE Towing Recovery, Case 232500134. The vehicle was later recovered.

On Wednesday, September 13, 2023, I conducted follow-up at 1434 S. Muskego Ave., MKE Towing and Recovery along with Squad 5821 Det. Jon Kramschuster, regarding the stolen car. I spoke to owner/ manager Mujtaba Zahid who was on scene.

Mujtaba stated he is the owner along with his father Ashraf Zahid. Regarding the stolen vehicle Mujaba stated he received the request for a tow through his dispatch center, which is located out of the country in Pakistan. The caller requested a tow and stated a key holder would meet the driver. When Mujtaba's tow driver arrived at the area where the vehicle was parked, he was not met by anyone and requested the tow by calling Mujtaba. Mujtaba advised his driver to conduct the tow. The vehicle was removed and taken to a location where it was dropped off on the public street in front of a vacant property. Mujtaba nor the driver obtained any identification from the person requesting the vehicle be towed. I advised Mujtaba that lack of information obtained before conducting the tow was violation of State and City requirements.

I also advised Mujtaba that a year-to-date check of city records shows his company requested 17 tow numbers from the City Parking Enforcement, for non-consensual tows, but I did not find a valid RSTP license number for his company. Mujtaba stated he did have a RST number and escorted me to the rear lot where he pointed out a truck displaying RST number 2408. I advised Mujtaba there was a note in the license search to place a hold on the application, due to no response from his company on a BOZA inspection so the RST was not granted.

I asked him about non-consensual vehicle storage. Mujtaba stated, vehicles are transported from that location to a lot he has at 206 W. Layton Ave., until the owner claims them. I advised Mujtaba of the following issues. He could not store nonconsensual towed vehicles at a location not on file with his license. Pricing needs to be posted in the office for public view. He should not conduct anymore non-consensual tows, Repo's, or salvage buys until he is granted a city license. I also advised that he apply for an RSTP, which includes the premises. I requested to meet with Mujtaba the following day at his storage lot and Det. Kramschuster and I ended the contact.

On Thursday September 14, 2023, I met with Mujtaba and his father the business agent Ashraf Zahid at 206 W. Layton Blvd. Mujtaba escorted me around the property and pointed out non-consensual towed vehicles still in his possession. After conducting VIN checks I advised Mujtaba to make a second attempt to contact the vehicle listed owners to have them recovered. I advised Mujtaba, seeing there was miscommunication between his company and the city he would not be cited for the non-consensual tows. I advised he will be cited for not obtaining information on the tow of the stolen vehicle.

Citation 683713B1Q is to be issued to Mujtaba for 93-47-4-C. Tow a vehicle without first obtaining adequate identification from the owner or authorized operator of the vehicle.

No additional enforcement at this time.

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.


