Dear Council Members:


Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers John Bartlett and Richard Jack. The claim is in the amount of \$883.18 including \$14.18 in disbursements for 7.90 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).


Dear Mr. Leonhardt:



decentralized LEA to the ground. Officer BARTLETT contends that he did observe what had transpired prior to LEA being taken to the ground. He reported however he did assist Officer JACK in handcuffing LEA.

On Wednesday June 7, 2000, Assistant District Attorney MURPHY did not prefer charges against Officers JACK and BARTLETT, citing the complainant's failure to show at the charging conference and insufficient evidence to prove the case beyond a reasonable doubt. Therefore, this incident will be cleared as warrant refused.
