Dear Alderman Donovan:

Parking restrictions were installed on the north side of West Lincoln Avenue from South 26th Street to South 28th Street to reduce congestion westbound on West Lincoln Avenue during afternoon peak periods. However, observations indicate that vehicles are not using the curb lane westbound from South 27th Street to South 28th Street despite high traffic volumes during afternoon peak periods. Therefore, since the restriction is unnecessary, we recommend the removal of signs prohibiting parking on the north side of West Lincoln Avenue from South Layton Boulevard to South 28th Street from 3:30 to 5:30 pm Monday through Friday.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting so that you may support it to final passage.
