**REASON FOR REQUEST:**

James Bocek, a City of Milwaukee Police Department employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling westbound on West Locust Street in the City of Milwaukee. As the claimant's vehicle was stopping for the red light at the intersection with North 7<sup>th</sup> Street, the uninsured motorist, who was following the City vehicle too closely, failed to stop and rear-ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to §62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Bocek sustained injuries to his head, neck and back. The treating orthopedic surgeon indicated there was a 2.5% permanent partial disability for the back injury. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$24,769.05.
