4. Will not cause a substantial rela-cation or reduction of parking, loading or recreation areas. The original DPD called for 134 parking spaces - 29 of which would be public. The modified DPD calls for 118 parking spaces - 29 of which will be public. This is nat a sub-stantial reduction in overall spaces and the public spaces remain the same. the public spaces remain the same.

5. Will not cause a substantial rela-

cation of traffic facilities.

6. Will not increase the land coverage of buildings and parking areas. The modified DPD reduces the land coverage of building area.

7. Will not increase the gross floar area of buildings or the number of

dwelling units.
