Allocation Purpose: The subaward from Sojourner Family Peace Center will fund .5 FTE Crime Analyst dedicated to DVHRT, overtime for MPD personnel to conduct investigations, contract investigators, IT workspace and rent for expanded space dedicated for DVHRT at Sojourner Family Peace Center.

Program Summary: The purpose of the grant is to expand the Milwaukee County Domestic Violence High Risk Team (DVHRT) capacity to identify and manage cases at highest risk for homicide to save lives. The grant will fund an expanded Crime Analyst to full-time with .5 FTE dedicated to DVHRT, overtime for MPD investigators working on DVHRT cases, contract investigators to provide case support for MPD investigators, and expanded MPD Sensitive Crimes Division workspace dedicated to DVHRT at the Sojourner Family Peace Center.

Note that this is a grant extension with additional funds. The original grant was for \$325,000 and the program period ended 12/31/24. This extension provides an additional \$448,751 and increases the grant term by 22 months.
