PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on July 19, 2004, Maurice Neal, Sr. of 3141 W. Juneau Avenue, Milwaukee Wisconsin, was involved in a motor vehicle accident that occurred when a City of Milwaukee Police Officer pursued Mr. Neal at a high rate of speed.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that as a proximate result of said accident, Maurice Neal, Sr., sustained personal injuries which resulted in his death and his son, Maurice Neal, Jr. sustained the loss of the society and companionship and monetary support of his father, he further makes a wrongful death claim.

Liability for the injuries is claimed as follows:

The City of Milwaukee on account of its liability for the acts of its unknown agents and employees as further set forth in this Notice of Injury and Claim for Damages, who were acting within the scope of their employment at the time of said accident.

The said accident was caused by the negligence of and on account of its employee/agent, for improperly forcing Mr. Neal to lose control of his vehicle and causing it to strike a tree, resulting in the aforementioned injuries and death.

As a proximate result of the above-described negligence, Maurice Neal, Sr. sustained personal injuries causing him to incur damages as itemized below:


As a proximate result of the above-described negligence, Maurice Neal, Jr., sustained damages as itemized below:
