STIPULATION AND ORDER FOR JUDGMENT

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED between the parties hereto, by the undersigned as the parties' respective attorneys, as follows:

1. Judgment may be granted in favor of the plaintiff, City of Milwaukee ("City"), and against the defendants ("Owners") in the amount of \$42,112.65, said figure including the principal balance of the outstanding real-property taxes for 1991-2002 against 3733 West Lisbon Avenue, Milwaukee (tax key no. 348-0101-100-6) plus accrued interest and penalties under Wis. Stat. §74.47 through July, 2003.

2. Owners shall pay to City, on or before July 31, 2003, via cashier's check made payable to "Wayne F. Whittow, City Treasurer," one lump-sum payment of \$27,721.12, and

City shall accept said \$27,721.12 as settlement and satisfaction in full of said judgment such settlement having been approved by City Common Council Resolution File No. 030376.
