This report is written by Police Officer Carlos Felix, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/15/19 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Country Inn located at 6200 S. 13<sup>th</sup> St. for a Trouble with Subject. On arrival it was determined a guest at the hotel was complaining about the smell of marijuana coming from the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. Officers determined which room it was coming from. An arrest was made and a subject was cited for possession of marijuana.

2. On 07/26/2020 at 10:56pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Country Inn & Suites, 6200 S 13<sup>th</sup> St. The officers interviewed the manager, who stated a hotel employee entered a guest's room without knocking. The guest became upset and was causing a disturbance in the lobby. The guest was asked to leave and he was packing up his items.

The subject was treated with Narcan and was revived. He stated he had been addicted to Heroin for 3 years bur had been clean for 7 months. He had a relapse today. The subject refused to go to the hospital.

people in a room causing a disturbance. The subjects left when he was advised the police were called.

Upon arrival, I was let into the hotel by the on-duty employee, Aliester S WHITE (W/M 08/11/1993). WHITE stated around 10 P.M tonight a family that is staying in rooms 224,226 and 232 were being disorderly and loud. The 911 call was placed by the WHITE because the family of approximately 20 people were physically fighting with other patrons on the second floor, primarily in room 212. WHITE stated all the guest involved have been very loud all night long and have to vacate the property due to their escalating behavior.

I made contact with one member of the aggressor party who was verbally identified as Mahogany D PARROW (F/B 0816/1981) stated tonight her daughter, Stephanie PARROW (F/B 04/23/2002) went downstairs with other children to the vending machine to buy snacks. During Stephanie PARROW'S transaction at the vending machine the kids were in the hallway when Stephanie Parrow was assaulted in the head. No medical attention was needed for Stephanie PARROW, and she appeared to be okay. Mahogany PARROW admitted she got into a physical altercation along other members of her party with other guests.

I spoke with an involved member in room 212. She identified herself by her Wisconsin Driver's license as Destiny Troy DEUEL (F/W 04/21/07). DEUEL stated her and her 5 friends were in room 212 when she could hear the kids yelling and screaming up and down the hallway. DEUEL and her friend had opened the door to room 212 and admitted they told the kids to " Shut the fuck up" and then closed the door. Shortly thereafter, the PARROW family came banging on their door. A man who was not on scene when officers arrived who only identified as " ISIAH" opened the door and was suddenly assaulted in the face by a slim black male who was shirtless. ISIAH and the black male fought face to face on the bed until other people intervened to break it up. Eventually DEUEL and her other members in her room were able to remove everyone out of the room. DEUEL's guests were all gone prior to officers' arrival.

The business employees were cooperative with the investigation. They attempted to show officers video

Medical attention was called for the female detainee, LOFTON. Officer REYES escorted her down to the main lobby of the hotel for Bell Ambulance 507 to evaluate her. LOFTON was not conveyed to the hospital. LOFTON refused to admit the truth to numerous officers on what occurred. LOFTON was shown a still image from the security camera still shot provided to me by the head property manager Robert BROWN (M/W 11/16/1976). Immediately after showing LOFTON the image she refused to cooperate any further, began changing her story and was not willing to answer any questions. Officers attempted to explain and negotiate with LOFTON, but she ultimately refused everything.

Sergeant Demeterious HUDSON, Officers Bertha GONZALEZ, Joseph DELANEY and I checked the area to locate the unknown subject.

The unknown subject was seen by a citizen boarding the bus northbound I-94 from college Avenue. The subject was no longer on scene.

I spoke with WHITE who showed me the licenses issued by the City of Milwaukee. The licenses were all up to date. At no point during this investigation did i observe any violations at the establishment. During the course of the investigation the staff was cooperative and complied with all requests. The security cameras appeared functional and live.

## INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is being written by Police Officer Jacob GUERRERO assigned to District 6, Early Shift, squad 6290.

On Wednesday, June 3rd 2026 at 11:45pm, squad 6290 (GUERRERO/J) and 6242 (LAUX/E, KRESA/T) were dispatched to the address of 6200 S 13th St (Country Inn and Suites) which is located in the city and county of Milwaukee, Wisconsin for a Battery complaint.

Upon arrival, I spoke to the Country Inn and Suites front desk employee identified as Gisselle SALAZAR (W/F DOB 02/14/1998). SALAZAR stated at approximately 11:40pm, she heard audible arguing from the second floor hotel room #226. SALAZAR stated she also began receiving several phone call complaints from other residents at the hotel who stated they could heard yelling and fighting going on inside of room #226. SALAZAR stated she then observed a white female running downstairs from the second floor in what appeared to be possibly blood on her face. SALAZAR stated the white female subject told her to hang up the phone, after she observed SALAZAR on the phone with 911.

SALAZAR stated she did not hang up and continued talking with the 911 operator. I asked SALAZAR if there was still anyone left inside of room #226, and SALAZAR stated yes, stating she wanted the other white female inside of the room removed as she had caused too many issues for the night. I walked upstairs to the second floor of the hotel and made my way to unit #226.

I made contact with the other white female inside of the unit who was identified as Abbey BLOOM (W/F DOB 05/15/1990). I asked BLOOM if everything was alright tonight and BLOOM stated yes. BLOOM stated she had been "bickering" with another female subject inside of the room and told her to leave before things escalated. I asked BLOOM if anything had gotten physical, and BLOOM stated no. I did not observe any blood or visible injuries on BLOOM while speaking to her. I then told BLOOM the hotel staff wanted her to leave and BLOOM packed her belongings and exited the Country Inn and Suites without further incident.

The business was cooperative with the investigation. I did not observe video surveillance footage of the incident. While on scene, I did not observe any licensee violations. The business posted licenses are up to date. Country Inn and Suites did not have any security guard working while I was on scene.
