Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. It was brought to my attention that Jimmy Boyd has applied for a secondhand motor vehicle dealership license from the City of Milwaukee. Mr. Boyd is currently on extended supervision, which is scheduled to discharge on 4-23-2020 for the offense of 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety & Possession with Intent to Deliver Cocaine (>40g).

- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Investigation revealed that three patrons had ordered some drinks and paid for same with a suspicious fifty-dollar bill. When police arrived, two out of the three patrons were still on scene and were questioned regarding the fifty-dollar bill. Further investigation revealed one of these patrons to be underage.
