

We are in receipt of your claim for damages to your residence, 536 N. 28th Street, occurring on December 9, 2019 that resulted from a balcony being blown off City owned property, located at 540 N. 28th Street.

We have conducted and concluded our investigation in this matter. Our investigation revealed that on December 9, 2019 Milwaukee experienced peak wind speeds up to 36 miles per hour. During this time, 540 N. 28th Street, was occupied and was in habitable condition. We rely on the tenants of the property, to notify the City property managers of any maintenance needs.

Our investigation concluded that the City had received no requests for maintenance issues at 540 N. 28th Street prior to this incident. Consequently, there is no evidence that the City was negligent in this matter. As such, the City would not be liable. Therefore, we are denying your claim.
