
Dear Mr. Adams:

This is to notify you that on Wednesday, October 21, 2015, the City's Public Works Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to deny your application for a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license based on your nonappearance despite being provided timely notice of the hearing.

On October 22, 2015, you were mailed true and correct copies of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Public Works Committee with respect to the renewal application for a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's license, in which the Committee recommended that the license not be renewed. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Monday, November 2, 2015, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear and you did not file written objections to the report of the Public Works Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Public Works Committee, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Public Works Committee to not renew the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver's licenses based on nonappearance. If you previously paid the license fees you may be eligible for a refund, except for a portion of the fee that may be retained, by bringing in your receipt or filing an application for a refund within one year to date of Common Council action with the License Division, Room 105, City Hall.






